

To register a domain, first of search the desired domain. For this, select Language, enter the required domain name, choose extension and click on 'Search Domain' to check domain availability.




If Domain is available then it will display with green tick and user can select 'Domain Period'. Now click on 'Apply' proceed further.




Now Instructions will be displayed on screen. Kindly, read the displayed instructions properly and click on 'Confirm' to proceed to 'Agreement Details' form.






In the received email, please read the instructions to download the Google Authenticator on your mobile phone. And, click on the link shared link through email to generate your login credentials.




Now, click on 'Create Password' to set your password and proceed to Next Page.




Now open the Google Authenticator app on mobile and user can either scan the QR code displayed on screen or manually input code to verify his mobile device.






Here, user is able to view his dashboard. Now, click on 'Contact Details Pending' to proceed to 'Domain Contact Details'.




Here, user can fill his details in 'Details of Institution' properly and click on 'Save' to proceedto 'Details of Head of Institution' and so on.




Here, user can fill his details as per requirements and click on 'Submit' to proceed on 'DNS Name Server Details'.

Here, user can view Payment Summaryand click on 'Make Payment' to proceed to 'Billing Details'.






Now the user must read 'Notes' and 'Instructions'. And upload all documents as per the requirements. Only PDF(s) are allowed.




After all the documents are uploaded. Now user will proceed to "Application Details – Preview". Here, user can review their details filled by them and proceed to final submit to ERNET India.




If ERNET India asks for any clarification required related to the uploaded documents then the status of the application will change to 'Documents Modification Required'.




Once the domain is activated, user can renew it only after 5 days from the date of activation. The link of "Renew" will get visible only after 5 days from the Domain Activation date.








The status of application will get changed to 'Applied for Renewal'.
